.Coop is the new Internet domain address for co-operatives. Authorized in 2001 by ICANN, the International Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers, .coop addresses were activated in January 2002. .Coop has over 6,000 domains owned by co-ops from over 50 countries. .Coop domain registrants are verified to be eligible co-operative organizations to assure consumers that they are dealing with a trusted co-operative or co-operative organization when they visit a .coop web site. The .coop domain is sponsored by dotCooperation LLC based in Washington, DC, USA with development support by the International Co-operative Alliance (ICA) based in Geneva, Switzerland.
