Cooperation with Dream Garden LTD



Farm Credit Armenia UCO CC and Dream Garden LTD signed an agreement

for cooperation in the scope of lease activities on March 2013. The Dream Garden LTD imports Italian

and Serbian agricultural equipments and is the sole representative of Serbian Agro Machinery Company in the Republic of Armenia. Besides the company is importing agricultural equipments and all the necessary spare parts for machinery. Imported equipments are of different kinds, such as a mower machine, carriage for transportation, seeding machine, limber and others.

This cooperation allows the farmers to obtain agricultural equipments with lease. Farm Credit Armenia will provide loans to those individuals who want to purchase agricultural equipments from the shop. Customers applying for the lease will not be required to make any down payment and the interest rate will start from 11%.

We believe that our cooperation will keep growing, thus we can make valuable contribution in development of rural Armenia.



Consecutive Board Training at FCA

"Farm Credit Armenia" UCO CC hosted trainers from the Texas A&M University Dr. John Penson and Chief Risk Officer of Opportunity International Lynn Exton, March 11-13, 2013. The aim of the visit was conducting workshops and trainings for FCA Board of Directors and top management team.

Within the scope of the trainings the following topics were discussed: board governance, risk management, the roles and responsibilities of board members, risk assessment, risk appetite, as well as the aims and objectives of a strategic business program, its aims and objectives, necessary amendment spheres, compatibility with FCA risk appetite and annual business plan.



The purpose of the workshop was to share international knowledge and practice with FCA staff. Those three days of seminars were highly efficient and productive. The methods that were used to conduct the workshop include round table discussions, case studies, and interactive discussions.
