# APCMC HISTORIC RESOLUTION & ADOPTION OF 33% RESERVATION



- THE ICA REGIONAL WOMEN'S COMMITTEE RESOLUTION WAS CARRIED AT THE 9TH ICA REGIONAL WOMEN'S FORUM AND VETTED BY THE WOMEN'S COMMITTEE AT KOBE, JAPAN. IT WAS PRESENTED AT THE ASIA-PACIFIC COOPERATIVE MINISTERS' CONFERENCE (APCMC) IN HANOI, VIETNAM IN APRIL, 2017 BY THE WOMEN'S COMMITTEE REPRESENTATIVES. (JCCU)
- THE APCMC RESOLUTION ADOPTED 30 TO 50% REPRESENTATION OF WOMEN IN COMMITTEES, BODIES, COUNCILS AND ALL OTHER HIGHER-LEVEL COOPERATIVE STRUCTURES.





## GENDER MORE THAN A STATISTIC – GENDER DISAGGREGATED DATA STUDY

- ✤ THE ICA-AP WOMEN'S COMMITTEE UNDERTOOK A PIONEERING REGIONAL STATUS STUDY ON WOMEN IN COOPERATIVES TO ASSESS THE SITUATION IN THE ASIA-PACIFIC REGION.
- THE STUDY FINDINGS WERE PRESENTED AT THE ASIA PACIFIC COOPERATIVE MINISTERS' CONFERENCE (APCMC) BY DR. NANDINI AZAD, ACTING CHAIR OF THE WOMEN'S COMMITTEE WHO UNDERTOOK THE STUDY.





## **KEY FINDINGS**



- WHILE WOMEN'S REPRESENTATION IN COOPERATIVES AT HIGHER ECHELONS WAS NOT SIGNIFICANT AT THE DECISION MAKING LEVELS – THE NEW TRENDS, DECISIONS, ISSUES INDICATE NEW THRESHOLD OF CHANGE FOR WOMEN.
- ✤ RATIO OF WOMEN CHAIRPERSONS INCREASED FROM 7% IN 2005 TO 10% IN 2016
- RATIO OF WOMEN VICE CHAIRPERSONS INCREASED FROM 18 % IN 2005 TO 23 %
  IN 2016

THE STUDY RECOMMENDED, AMONGST OTHERS FOR GENDER INTEGRATION IN COOPERATIVES THE FOLLOWING : THE FORMATION OF "GENDER EQUALITY COMMITTEES", INCREASING MEMBERSHIP OF WOMEN, GENDER DISAGGREGATED DATA STUDIES, TRACKING EQUALITY INDICATORS SUCH AS WOMEN'S PARTICIPATION IN GOVERNANCE, MANAGEMENT, MEMBERSHIP ETC.

## GENDER EQUALITY STRATEGY 2017-2020 VISION & OBJECTIVES



THE WOMEN'S COMMITTEE DEVELOPED A STRATEGY TO ACHIEVE GENDER EQUALITY AS FOLLOWS.

#### VISION

- TO ENSURE A MINIMUM OF 30-50% PARTICIPATION OF WOMEN AT ALL LEVELS IN COOPERATIVES.
- ✤ REPRESENTATION OF ALL ICA-AP MEMBERS ON THE WOMEN'S COMMITTEE

#### **OBJECTIVES**

- TO ENSURE INSTITUTIONALIZATION OF 'EQUAL OPPORTUNITY'
  FOR WOMEN, IF NEED BE, BY INTRODUCING QUOTAS.
- TO INSTITUTIONALIZE COLLECTION AND USE OF GENDER DISAGGREGATED DATA IN COOPERATIVES

- **STRATEGY-1** INCREASING MEMBERSHIP OF THE ICA-AP COMMITTEE ON
- WOMEN (7 COUNTRIES DURING THE TARGET PERIOD)
- STRATEGY-2 REGULAR COLLECTION, ANALYSIS AND SHARING OF
- GENDER DISAGGREGATED DATA (ONCE DURING PERIOD)
- **STRATEGY-3** PERIODICAL MONITORING, FOLLOW UP AND EVALUATION OF THE PROGRAMS BEING IMPLEMENTED BY THE ICA-AP COMMITTEE ON WOMEN (TWICE DURING PERIOD)

### CASE STUDIES OF CO-OPERATIVES FROM THE ASIA PACIFIC REGION

### **THE PHILIPPINES**

- ONE OF THE FEW COUNTRIES IN ASIA-PACIFIC WITH AN EQUAL SEX RATIO OF 101.
- MALE TO FEMALE RATIO IS 46.8M TO 46.4M. LITERACY
  RATE IS HIGHER FOR WOMEN AT 96% (95% FOR MEN)
- HAS SEVERAL PRO-WOMEN LAWS TO PROMOTE INTEGRATION OF WOMEN AS EQUAL PARTNERS IN DEVELOPMENT - VICTO AND NATCCO, NATIONAL
   CO-OPERATIVE FEDERATIONS, REFLECT THESE AT ALL











#### THE NATIONAL CONFEDERATION OF COOPERATIVES (NATCCO)



IT REACHES 2.17 MILLION INDIVIDUAL MEMBERS - 612 RURAL AND URBAN-BASED COOPERATIVES; 1,132 OFFICES LOCATED IN 136 PROVINCES AND CITIES COUNTRYWIDE. MEMBERS - 66% WOMEN & 48% MEN; AT BOARD LEVEL - 52% WOMEN & 48% MEN

#### NATIONAL COOPERATIVE FEDERATION LTD. (VICTO)

IT HAS 250.699 INDIVIDUAL MEMBERS WITHIN ITS 2008 MEMBER SOCIETIES. MEASURES INCLUDE:

# THE JAPANESE CONSUMERS' CO-OPERATIVE UNION (JCCU)

JAPANESE CONSUMERS' COOPERATIVE UNION (JCCU) IS APEX OF CONSUMER COOPERATIVES IN JAPAN (1951). 619 MEMBER CO-OPERATIVES - REGIONAL RETAIL, INSTITUTIONAL, UNIVERSITY, HEALTH, AND INSURANCE (MUTUAL-AID) CO-OPERATIVES.



- A GENDER EQUALITY COMMITTEE/ ADVISORY COMMITTEE IN BOARD WAS INITIATED FROM SEPT. 2015. A BOARD MEMBER OF JCCU IS ON THE GENDER EQUALITY PROMOTION COMMITTEE (CABINET OFFICE).
- WOMEN PLAY VERY ACTIVE ROLE IN THE CONSUMER COOPS IN JAPAN (37% OF HOUSEHOLDS COUNTRYWIDE).







- ✤ COOPERATIVES HAVE A HISTORY OF 60 YEARS IN CHINA AND AN IMPORTANT ASPECT OF PROMOTING AGRICULTURAL AND RURAL ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT.
- ★ THE ALL CHINA FEDERATION OF SUPPLY AND MARKETING COOPERATIVES (ACFSMC) IS THE NATIONAL APEX COOPERATIVE WITH A TOTAL OF 6.27 MILLION RURAL HOUSEHOLDS, EMPLOYING A TOTAL OF 3.67 MILLION STAFF.
- ✤ FEMALE STAFF AND MIDDLE LEVEL LEADERS ACCOUNT FOR 40%; THE CHAIRMAN, COUNCIL DIRECTORS ARE WOMEN.
- SALE OF AGRICULTURAL SUPPLIES TO FARMERS IS 428.7 BILLION RMB;
  COOPERATIVES PURCHASED AGRICULTURAL SIDELINE PRODUCTS WORTH 669.7
  BILLION RMB .









#### INDIAN COOPERATIVE NETWORK FOR WOMEN (ICNW) PROMOTED BY WORKING WOMEN'S FORUM (INDIA)

- ENGAGE POOR WOMEN IN PRODUCTIVE ACTIVITIES, ENSURE OVERALL EMPOWERMENT
- FIRST WOMEN'S COOPERATIVE IN SOUTH INDIA FOR, BY AND OF POOR WOMEN INITIATED IN 1981
- FACILITATES ACCESS TO CREDIT, PROVIDING OPPORTUNITIES TO LEARN NEW SKILLS, AND SECURING EMPLOYMENT FOR WOMEN.
- DISBURSED CREDIT LOANS WORTH OVER INR. 3000 MILLION SO FAR TO 5,86,790
  WOMEN ENTREPRENEURS WITH 99% RECOVER IN APPROX 6000 SLUMS/VILLAGES.







- Als 14 COOPERATIVE BRANCHES IN THE THREE SOUTHERN STATES OF INDIA-TAMIL NADU, KARNATAKA AND ANDHRA PRADESH.
- ✤ MEMBERS ARE VENDORS, HAWKERS, FISHER-WOMEN, LANDLESS WOMEN, CIGARETTE ROLLERS, SILK WEAVERS, INCENSE WORKERS, LACE MAKERS, AND SEVERAL OTHER MICRO ENTREPRENEURS (276 OCCUPATIONS).
- ✤ INNOVATIVE BOTTOM-UP STRUCTURE AND TRAINING/ORIENTATION FACILITATED WOMEN TO PARTICIPATE AT ALL LEVELS.
- ICNW MOBILIZES POOR RURAL/URBAN WOMEN BELOW POVERTY LINE TO FORM
  CREDIT GROUPS (OF AROUND 10 MEMBERS EACH) TO IDENTIFY, SHARE, DISCUSS
  PROBLEMS AND FIND SOLUTIONS TOGETHER.

# ICNW – A ROLE MODEL FOR GENDER

- ✤ GRASSROOTS WOMEN OCCUPY IMPORTANT POSITIONS IN THE ALL-WOMEN BOARD AND ARE PART OF DECISION MAKING PROCESS.
- WOMEN-INTENSIVE ORGANIZATION PROMOTED POOR WOMEN, PROVIDED OPPORTUNITY TO ADDRESS CHALLENGES SUCCESSFULLY (AS WOMEN, HOME MAKERS, COMMUNITY LEADERS).
- ✤ HIGH LEVEL OF FINANCIAL OUTPUT DELIVERY.
- BENEFITS TO MEMBERS ARE LEADERSHIP, ECONOMIC, BUSINESS, SOCIAL, PERSONAL







## **ICNW VISION**



- DEMONSTRATES EVEN THE POOREST AND SEMI-LITERATE WOMEN CAN MANAGE INSTITUTIONS, WITH THE RIGHT KIND OF TRAINING/ORIENTATION AND FIELD EXPOSURE.
- ONE POOR WOMAN IDENTIFYING TEN OTHER POOR WOMEN IN HER AREA AS PROSPECTIVE BORROWERS HAS MADE POSSIBLE A PHENOMENAL OUTREACH.
- HAS INFUSED CONFIDENCE AMONG THE MEMBERS, RAISED STANDARD OF LIVING, UPHOLDING HUMAN DIGNITY, HELPED REDISTRIBUTION OF RESOURCES ENSURING SOCIAL JUSTICE AND POSITIVE SOCIAL CHANGE.









#### \* ICOOP



- ICOOP KOREA HAS 73 PRIMARY CO-OPERATIVES WITH OBJECTIVE OF SAFE FOOD FOR MEMBERS' FAMILIES.
- ✤ 1,200 WOMEN RUN PRIMARY CO-OPERATIVE COMMITTEES IN FOOD SAFETY, ENVIRONMENT, CHILDCARE, EDUCATION AND AGRICULTURAL SUPPORT NATIONALLY.
- ✤ ICOOP INITIATED THE MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT OF CO-OPERATIVES FOR PROFESSIONALS WITH SUNGKONGHOE UNIVERSITY IN 2010.
