Cooperatives: potential solutions to wipe out hunger and poverty, according to the President of Costa Rica



The cooperative model offers unique solutions to "free people from hunger and poverty in a globalized world in which crises, including climate change, touch everyone," said Laura Chinchilla, President of Costa Rica, in a speech last week at the FAO.

Using her own country as an example, the President emphasized that cooperatives can make major contributions to sustainable development and the competitiveness of small agricultural producers.
