Geneva: Useful Information



Old Town

No Smoking: Smoking is prohibited in all public places in Geneva including restaurants and bars.

Banks & Currency Exchange: The local currency is the Swiss Franc (CHF). Major banks and exchange offices are located throughout Geneva. Banks normally are open non-stop between 08:30-16:30, Monday to Friday.

Store hours: Most shops in the city centre are open non-stop from 09:00-18:30 from Monday to Wednesday, 09.00-21:00 on Thursday, 09:00-19:30 on Friday, and 09:00-18:00 on Saturday. Shops are closed on Sundays.

Restaurants & Tipping: Restaurants normally open for lunch at 12:00 and serve until 14:00. Restaurants open for dinner at 19:30 and serve until 22:00. Some restaurants in the centre to have non-stop service throughout the day. Service is included on all bills, but it is customary to leave a tip for good service.

Electricity: Switzerland operates on 220-240 volts AC, 50 Hz. There are three types of plugs in Switzerland.
