

ENTRY CONDITIONS AND RULES

Contest period

The “#CoopsFor2030” contest is organized by the International Co-operative Alliance and the International Summit of Cooperatives (hereafter the “Organizers”) and will run from July 2nd, 2016, at 8:30 a.m. Brussels time to July 29, 2016, at 5 p.m. Brussels time (hereafter the “contest period”).

Eligibility

This contest is open to all eligible members of co-operative enterprises (hereafter “eligible entrants”).

How to enter

To enter the contest, an eligible entrant must visit the www.coopsfor2030.coop site and make a pledge by following the instructions.

Prize

A single prize will be awarded consisting of a pass for one person to attend the three-day [International Summit of Cooperatives](#) to be held in Quebec City from October 11 to 13, 2016, a \$1,500 value. The pass includes admission to the Summit [Rendez-vous](#) and [pre-Summit activities](#) (October 10), to B2B activities and to the Around the World Cocktail Party. Please note that conference-lunch activities are not included.

Choice of winner

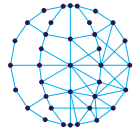
The winner will be selected at random from among all participants. The name will be drawn on July 29, 2016, by the representatives of the International Co-operative alliance and the International Summit of Cooperatives Communications Department in the office of one of the Organizers.

To take possession of the prize, the winner must acknowledge receipt of the email sent by the Summit within seven (7) days of it being sent. The winner’s name will be announced on www.coopsfor2030.coop and on social networks.

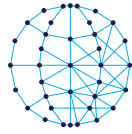
General terms and conditions

1. In order to be declared winner, the selected entrant must:
 - a) Be reached by email by the Organizer within 2 days of being selected
 - b) Confirm that he or she fulfills the eligibility criteria and other requirements set forth in these rules
 - c) Sign the declaration and release form (“the Release Form”), which will be sent by email or fax, and return it to the Organizer within 5 business days of its receipt

If the winner fails to comply with any of the above terms and conditions or any other condition herein, the selected entrant will be disqualified and, at the Organizers’ discretion, the prize will be cancelled or a new draw for the prize will be held in accordance with these contest rules until another entrant has been selected and declared winner of the prize. The same terms and conditions will continue to apply for any modifications deemed necessary.



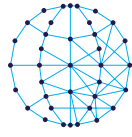
2. Awarding of the prize. Within 15 days of receiving the Release Form, the Organizers will send the winner a letter outlining the prize acceptance procedures. In the event the selected entrant refuses to accept his or her prize, the Organizers will be relieved of any obligation regarding the awarding of the prize and may, at its discretion, cancel the prize or hold a new draw in accordance with the procedures set out in the previous paragraph.
3. Verification. Entries and Release Forms are subject to verification by the Organizers. Any entry or Release Form that is incomplete, incorrect, illegible, mechanically reproduced, mutilated, fraudulent, registered or submitted late, or is otherwise non-compliant may be rejected and will not entitle the entrant to the prize.
4. Disqualification. Anyone who enters or tries to enter the contest by any means that violate these rules or are unfair to other entrants (e.g., software piracy, use of voting groups, or use of a nominee) will be automatically disqualified and may be reported to the appropriate legal authorities.
5. Contest operation. Any attempt to sabotage the legitimate operation of this contest constitutes a violation of civil and criminal law. If such an attempt is made, the Organizers reserve the right to reject the contestant's entry and take legal action.
6. Prize acceptance. The prize must be accepted as described herein and may not be exchanged, substituted, or transferred to any other person, unless otherwise stipulated herein.
7. Limitation of liability. Should the Organize be unable to award the prize as described herein, it reserves the right to award a prize of the same type and equivalent value or, at its sole discretion, the cash value of the prize indicated herein. In no case shall the Organizers be required to award more prizes or award a prize other than in compliance with these rules.
8. Limitation of liability: Use of the prize. The winner releases the Organizers and the persons on whose behalf the contest is held from any responsibility with respect to any damage incurred as a result of participating in the contest, or accepting or using the prize. The winner acknowledges that upon receipt of the prize or the letter confirming the prize, fulfillment of the obligations related to the prize become the sole and exclusive responsibility of the various product and service providers. The winner undertakes to sign a declaration and release form to that effect. The winner acknowledges that the only guarantee applicable to the prize is the standard manufacturer's warranty.
9. Limitation of liability: Contest operation. The Organizers and persons on whose behalf the contest is held shall not be liable for any malfunction of any computer component, software or communication line, loss or lack of network communication, or any transmission that is faulty, incomplete, incomprehensible, or deleted by any computer or network that may limit or prevent any person from reading the contest rules and regulations. They shall not be held liable with respect to any loss or damage that may be caused directly or indirectly, in whole or in part, by any Web page or software download and/or transmission of any information concerning participation in the contest. More specifically, if the administration, security, fairness, integrity, or proper operation of the contest is compromised or seriously impacted, particularly due to a virus, bug, tampering, unauthorized action, fraud, technical failure, or any other cause, the Organizers reserve the right to cancel, modify, extend, or suspend the contest without notice.



10. Limitation of liability: Receipt of entries. The Organizers and the persons on whose behalf the contest is held are not liable for lost, misdirected, or late entries, including when resulting from a postal service issue or any failure whatsoever of the website during the contest period, including any damage to a participant's computer or mobile device.
11. Limitation of liability: Situation beyond the Organizers' control. The Organizers and the persons on whose behalf the contest is held will not be held liable in any way whatsoever for any situation in which their inability to act results from an event or situation beyond their control or from a strike, lockout, or any other labour dispute in the establishments of the organizations or firms whose services are used to hold this contest.
12. Contest modification. The Organizers reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel, terminate, modify, or suspend this contest, in whole or in part, should human intervention or an event occur that could alter or affect the administration, security, impartiality, or conduct of the contest as provided herein. The Organizers cannot be held liable for any changes.
13. Termination of contest entry. If contest entry must be terminated, in whole or in part, for whatever reason, before the closing date provided herein, the Organizers may proceed, at its sole discretion, with a draw from among the entries duly received and registered up to the date of the event ending contest entry.
14. Under no circumstances will the Organizers be required to award more prizes than indicated here in or award a prize other than in compliance with these rules.
15. Limitation of liability: Contest entry. Persons who enter or attempt to enter this contest release the Organizers and the persons on whose behalf the contest is held from any and all liability for any damages they may incur as a result of entering or attempting to enter the contest.
16. By accepting the prize, the winner authorizes the Organizers and/or the persons on whose behalf the contest is held to use, if required, his or her name, photo, image, voice, place of residence, and/or statement regarding the prize for publicity purposes, without any form of compensation.
17. Communication with entrants. No communication or correspondence will be exchanged with entrants during this contest except as provided herein or at the Organizers' initiative or to obtain consent to use entries from participants who entered the contest without purchase or consideration.
18. Personal information. Personal information gathered on entrants during the contest will be used solely to administer the contest. No communication, commercial or otherwise, that is not related to the contest will be sent to entrants, unless entrants have otherwise given their consent.
19. Property. The submitted photos and Release Forms are the property of the Organizers and will not be returned to entrants under any circumstances.
20. Decisions. All persons who enter the contest agree to be bound by these contest rules and to final decisions by the Organizers administering the contest.
21. If a section of these contest rules is declared or deemed illegal, unenforceable, or invalid by a competent court, then that section will be considered invalid, but all other sections that are not affected will be enforced within the limits of the law.
