SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Abstract Pathway

- Author submits an abstract (400 words).
- The abstract is sent for review.
- If accepted, author(s) must submit a full draft paper within 3 weeks of receiving feedback and the draft paper must be submitted before the submissions closing date.
- Paper is sent for review and final feedback is shared with author(s).

Full Draft Paper Pathway

- Author submits a full draft paper in line with the conference manuscript guidelines.
- The paper is sent for review.
- Reviewer reports are received, and feedback is sent to author(s).
- If, accepted, author(s) must implement any recommendations and submit final draft.

The Submission Process

The conference has two pathways to submission. Authors can submit an abstract or a draft paper. The following steps are followed in each of the pathways.

Abstract Pathway

- Author submits an abstract (400 words)
- The abstract is sent for review.
- Once received, the review feedback is sent to the author(s).
- If accepted, author(s) must submit a full draft paper within 3 weeks of receiving feedback and the draft paper must be submitted before the submissions closing date.
- Paper is sent for review and final feedback is shared with author(s).

Full Draft Paper Pathway

- Author submits a full draft paper in line with the conference manuscript guidelines.
- The paper is sent for review.
- Reviewer reports are received, and feedback is sent to author(s).
- If, accepted, author(s) must implement any recommendations and submit final draft.

Fees
