#### **Special Commemorative Event**

#### <u>"Cooperatives and Sustainable Development :</u> Maintaining momentum and exploring new avenues"

#### 1. Background

Cooperatives are member-owned and democratically controlled enterprises that operate across all sectors of the economy. The cooperative model has proven to be a powerful tool for advancing sustainable development, promoting inclusive economic growth, and fostering democratic participation.

The United Nations General Assembly proclaimed 2025 as the International Year of Cooperatives to highlight the significant role that cooperative enterprises play in economic development, poverty reduction, employment creation, and social integration worldwide. Cooperatives are people-centered enterprises owned and run by and for their members. They operate across all sectors, from agriculture and housing to finance and health, embodying values of self-help, democracy, equality, and solidarity.

Underlining the vital role cooperatives played in India's growth story, H.E. Mr. Narendra Modi, Prime Minister of India launched the UN International Year of Cooperatives 2025 at the ICA Global Cooperative Conference on 25<sup>th</sup> November 2024 in New Delhi. The event marked an important moment in demonstrating the power of cooperatives in tackling national challenges of inclusive development as well as global challenges like inequality, climate and food insecurity.

#### 2. Introduction

In recognition of the United Nations' proclamation of 2025 as the International Year of Cooperatives, the Permanent Mission of India will organize a special commemorative event on the theme - "Cooperatives and Sustainable Development : Maintaining momentum and exploring new avenues" - to celebrate the achievements of cooperatives, promoting awareness of their socio-economic contributions, and exploring pathways to strengthen and sustain the cooperative movement in the years ahead.
